MAJOR PROBLEMS IN INDIA

India has secured a place in the world as one of the fastest growing economy. In spite of this speedy economic growth, more than 45% of people live below the poverty line. The following are some of the crucial issues that our country face and these retard the economic development of individuals. They **are poverty, illiteracy, population explosion, unemployment, corruption, child labor, racism, classism and terrorism.**

POVERTY

According to the 2013 Indian Planning Commission's estimate, around 269 million people i.e. 22% of the total population lives below the poverty line. India holds one-third of the total powerful people in the world. According to the World Bank's report around 32% of the world is below the poverty line and around 68% earn only two USDs per day. From this data we can understand that a considerable number of people are leading a hard life of hand to mouth existence.

ILLITERACY

The literacy rate of India is 84% and when compared to the countries of the world, India has the largest number of illiterates. Despite government programs, the rate has increased sluggishly. The 1990 study reveals the fact that it would take 2060 to reach the universal literacy rate. The 2011 census indicated a literacy growth of 9.2% which is considerably lower than the previous decade.

POPULATION

At present, India's population is 1.3 billion and it is the second most populated country in the world. This is 17.31% of the total world population which means one out of six people in the world live in India. Research on the study of population states that India records 33 births per minute and 2000 births per hour and 48,000 per day. The availability of resource is not sufficed to cater to the needs of this tremendous explosion in population.

UNEMPLOYMENT

In India 9e% people are employed in unorganized sector. Some work for daily wages like porter, cart-pullers, vendors etc. The various schemes for self-employment have numerous constraints that it could not be utilized by the common man. These could be utilized only by people who have power in society or monetary power. This leads to people seek job elsewhere. This problem can be solved only when youth get vocational education and unite to start small scale industries. The government should support such youth and help in marketing their product. The youth of India would then become a role model for the entire world.

CORRUPTION

Corruption ruins the spike of the nation. It has adverse effect on the economy of India. India is ranked 95 out of 179 countries in Transparency International Perception Index. This score has increased consistently from 2.7 in 2002 to 3.1 in 2011. Instance of corruption are too many and heart rending and it seems to be never ending. If India were a nation devoid of corruption, the level of poverty and unemployment would be much lower.

CHILD LABOUR

Child labor is the worst social evil. Children are employed and exploited in spite of the Government law against this evil. They are employed in dangerous factories like crackers and match factories where they are paid less and lose their lives in fire accidents. The laws of the government are not obeyed by the money-making monsters. Poverty is an important reason of child labor. School drop-outs and the need for money to lead luxurious lives of teen-agers and increasing number of alcohol and drug users in families are other causes.

CONCLUSION

The right solution for all these problems can only be the right education. An education which could make people self-reliant, teach good values of life like loyalty, truthfulness, cleanliness, magnanimity etc., make people aware of evils and superstitions and make every one good human is the need of the hour. As student- teachers, let's take an oath to impart such education and produce good citizens to make the world a better place.
